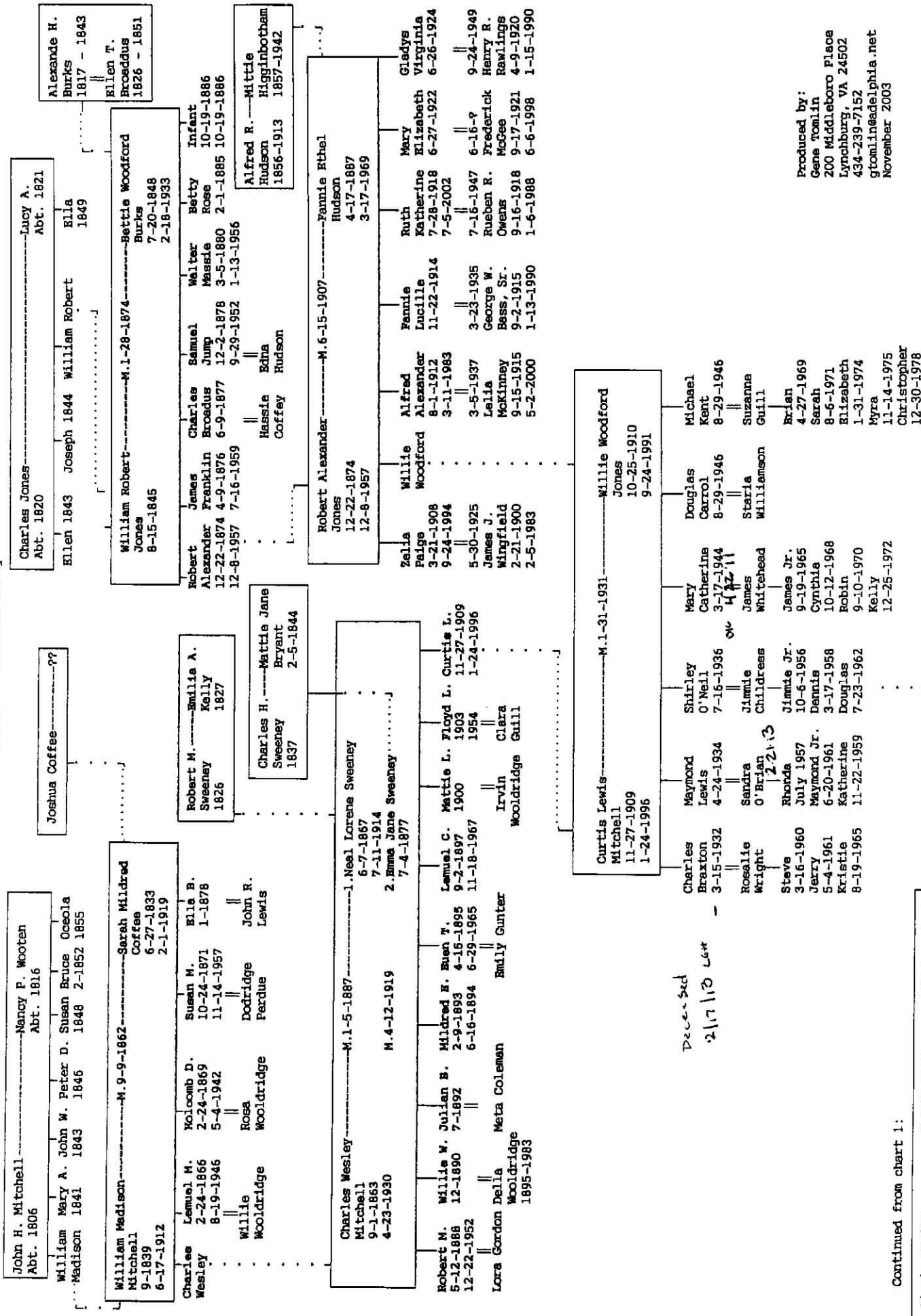

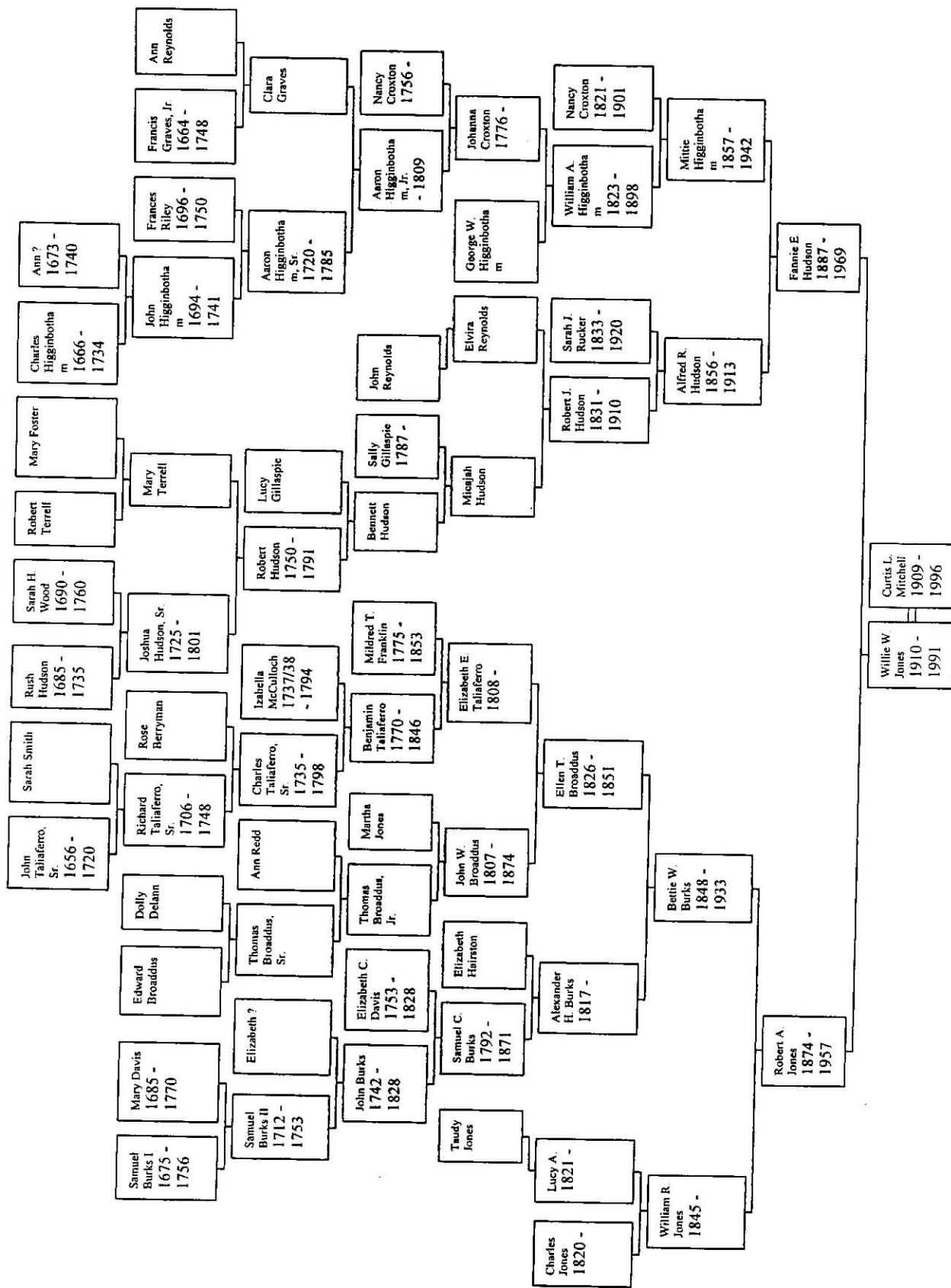

In marriage records for Appomattox it shows him as being 22 when married and Mildred S. Coffee as 25. He was listed as being born in Prince Edward County, and she in Lynchburg. His father was listed as John H. Mitchell and her's as Joshua Coffee. William Mitchell was a soldier at the time, living in Appomattox and the minister was Alan Thomas.

1880 census Appomattox County: William M. Mitchell 40, Mildred 45, Charlie 16, Lemuel 14, Holcomb 11, Susan 8, and Ella 2. His father was living in the house just before his.

1900 census Appomattox County he and his wife were living with Lem M. Mitchell he was listed as being born Sept. 1839 and Mildred June 1833.

Were living with Susan and her family in the 1910 census William was 70 and Mildred was 77 according to the census report.

Application of Soldier, Sailor or Marine for a Pension.

I, William M. Mitchell of the County of Appomattox in said State of Virginia, resident at Mark Appomattox in the County of Appomattox in said State of Virginia, and who was a soldier from the State of Virginia in the war between the United States and the Confederate States, do hereby apply for aid under an act of the General Assembly, approved March 7, 1864, entitled "An act to give aid to soldiers, sailors, and marines disabled in the war between the States, and to every such soldier, sailor, or marine who by disease or other infirmities of age, is disabled from earning or is without the means of procuring a support, and to the widows of Virginia soldiers, sailors, or marines who lost their lives in said war in the military or naval service, or whose husbands have died since the war." And I do solemnly swear that I was a member of Capt. Wm. Adams Johnson's Artillery, Major M. D. Cook's Battalion and that I am now disabled by reason of old age and infirmity from the effects thereof and from disease and that by reason of such disability I am now entitled to receive, under said Act, the sum of Thirty dollars, annually. I further swear that I do not hold any National, State, or County office which pays me in salary or fees over three hundred dollars per annum; nor have I an income from any other source which amounts to three hundred dollars; nor do I own in my own right, nor does my wife own, property of the assessed value of more than one thousand dollars; nor do I receive aid or a pension from any other State or from the United States; and that I am not a inmate of any soldiers' home.

I do further swear that the answers given to the following questions are true:

I filed the said application for aid under the provisions of an act of the General Assembly approved March 7, 1900, in and for the county of Appomattox, in the State of Virginia, and of the Confederate States during the war between the States, and that I am now an actual resident of the county of Appomattox, in the said State, and that I do not hold any national, State, city, or county office which pays me in salary or fees one hundred and fifty dollars per annum; nor have I an income from any other employment or other source whatever which amounts to one hundred and fifty dollars per annum; nor do I receive from any source whatever money or other income of support amounting in value to the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars per annum; nor do I own in my own right, nor does any one hold in trust for my benefit or use, nor does my wife own, nor does any one hold in trust for the benefit of my wife, either real, personal or mixed property or estate, either in fee or for life, of the assessed value of five hundred dollars; nor do I receive any aid or pension from any other State, or from the United States, or from any other source, and that I am not an inmate of the Soldiers' Home or other public institution. 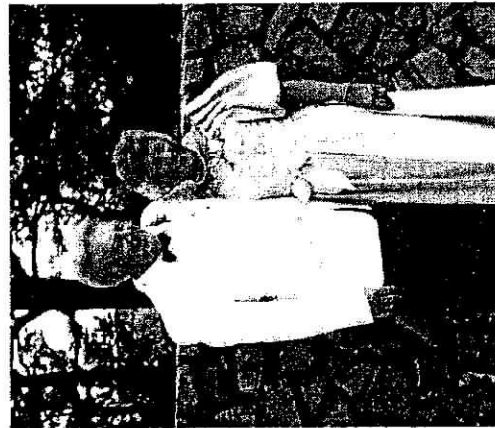

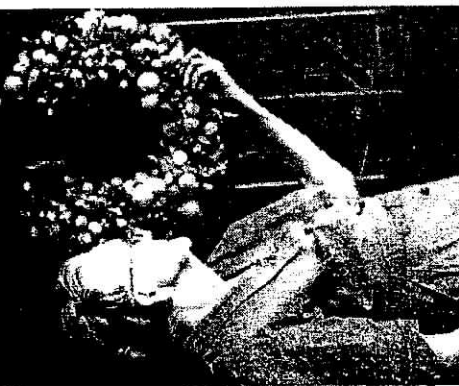

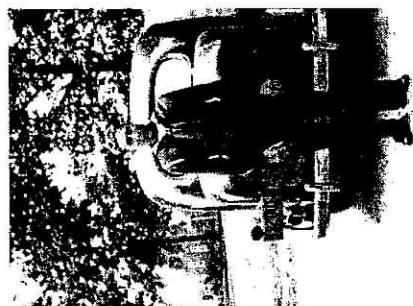

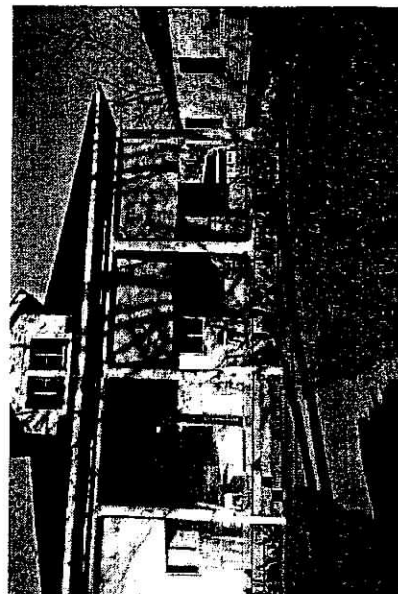

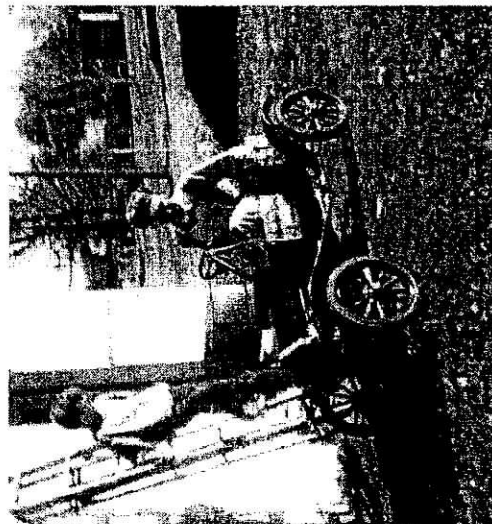

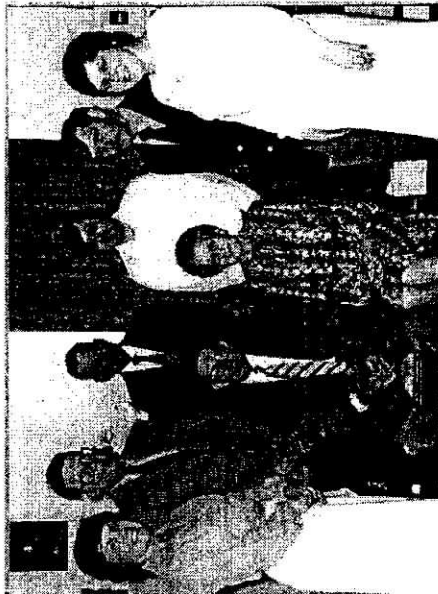

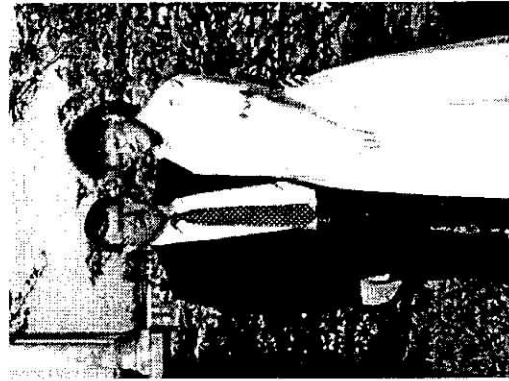

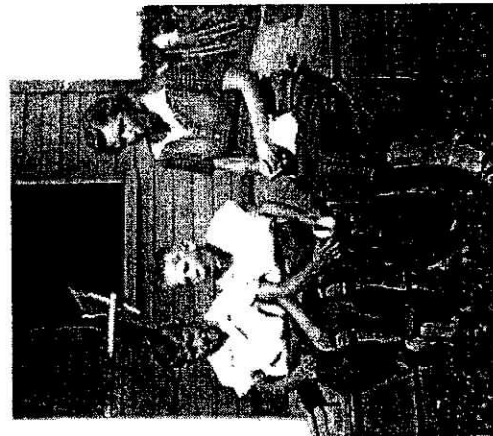
